Project Description

The Lexington Community Land Trust, a 501c3 nonprofit organization, is constructing a community center in the Davis Park, formerly Davis Bottom, community. The neighborhood was formerly razed as part of the Newtown Pike Extension road project. The community center is an integral part of the revitalization of the community and is required by the Record of Decision in place. The community center will serve as a hub for the formerly displace residents and all the new residents living in Davis Park which is an affordable housing development.

How does this project prioritize equitable outcomes?

The project is situation in the Davis Park, formerly Davis Bottom, economic and racial equity and promote community which is traditionally a low-income minority community. It was razed by the Newtown Pike Extension road project and is being revitalized by the Lexington Community Land Trust. The Lexington Community Land Trust is a 501c3 nonprofit organization that creates permanently affordable housing with the focus on creating high quality housing stock, increasing home ownership rates especially for minority buyers and restoring a sense of community to the neighborhood.
