SUBJECT: Geopliant, LLC License and Service Agreement for Crisis Track Software

Request: Council authorization to execute license and service agreement with Geopliant, LLC for Crisis Track license software for the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management at a cost not to exceed \$6,200.

Purpose of Request: The Kentucky Division of Emergency Management is replacing existing software. The purpose of the software is to track damage locations and cost during a disaster situation. Crisis Track provides reporting for both public assistance and individual assistance that FEMA requires. The software allows projections of debris amount and dollars. It will integrate with Geographic Information Service (GIS), PVA and WebEOC, Emergency Management's current disaster management system.

What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years? Cost in this budget year is \$6200.
