

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_ - 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-47(A) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO SAFETY OFFICERS TO AMEND THE MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT FROM TWENTY –ONE (21) YEARS OF AGE TO EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 — That Section 18-47(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

- (a) All person appointed to the classified civil service position of safety officer, established in section 21-5 of this Code, shall have such qualifications, both physical and educational, which will permit the performance of the duties of safety officers, both as hereinafter defined and in accordance with such requirements as may be established from time to time by the mayor. Safety offices shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. Safety officers shall successfully complete at least one hundred twenty (120) hours of appropriate training, certified by the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council prior to being appointed. Safety officers shall not be members of the police department within the meaning of KRS 95.010(2), nor entitled to share in the policemen's and firemen's retirement fund.

Section 2 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
