**SUBJECT REQUEST COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE SECOND
AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH AMEC ENVIRONMENT &
INFRASTRUCTURE, INC., (FORMERLY KNOWN AS AMEC EARTH &
ENVIRONMENTAL, INC.) FOR ADDITIONAL BROWNFIELD SITE
ASSESSMENT SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,362.83**

On January 13, 2011 (Resolution No. 4-2011), Council approved execution of Agreement with AMEC Earth & Environmental, Inc., to perform Phase I and Phase II environmental site assessments and to develop cleanup plans under the in the amount of \$140,220 under the LFUCG's Brownfields Assessment and Cleanup Cooperative Agreement for petroleum contaminated sites, as awarded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This organization was selected to perform these services pursuant to RFP 49-2010.


On December 1, 2011 (Resolution No. 544-2011), Council approved execution of Amendment to Agreement with AMEC Environment and Infrastructure, Inc. in the amount of \$246,430 for additional brownfield assessment services, for a total amount of \$386,650.

The Division of Environmental Policy is proposing a second amendment to the agreement, requesting that AMEC Environmental and Infrastructure, Inc. provide additional brownfield assessment services in the amount of \$6,362.83 for a new total of \$393,012.83.
