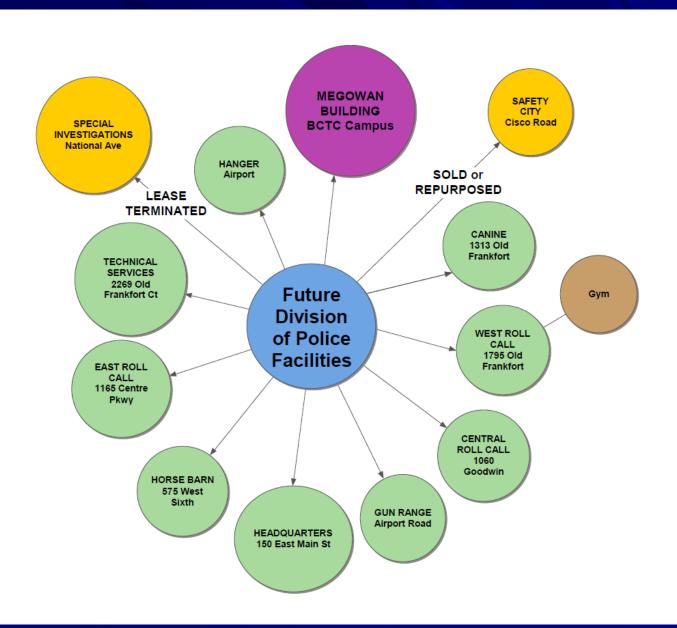

# ESTIMATED YEARLY OPERATING COSTS

#### **Based on 20,000 Square Feet**

Utilities	\$ 60,	000
Mech Maint Contract	\$ 10,	000
BCTC Maintenance	\$ 3,	000
Major Repair Budget	\$ 7,	000
Custodial (< actual)	\$ 8,	000
Total	\$ 88,	000

BCTC Share		
21% Facility	\$88000 X .21 =	\$ 18,480

LPD Share		
79% Facility	\$88000 X .79 =	\$ 69,520

Amortization of LPD Improvements
\$200,000 / 10 Year Amortization=\$20,000/yr

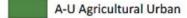

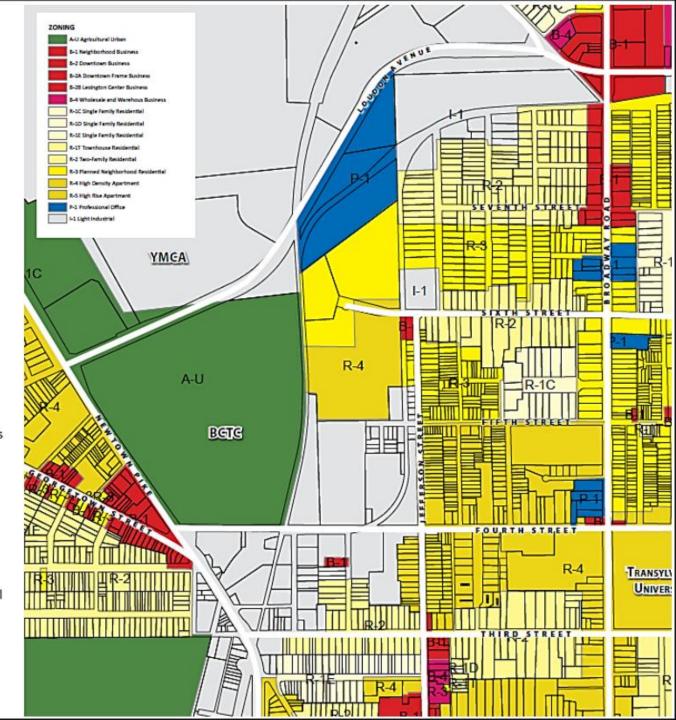
