Request

Authorization to accept the attached agreements with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Provisional State & Local Task Force, Appendix C & Certification, and Program Funded State & Local Task Force, Appendix D & Certification. The term of the agreements shall be from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Why are you requesting?

This agreement allows the continuation of the DEA State & Local Task Force, in which the Lexington Police Department has two (2) assigned detectives. The duties of the task force are as listed:

- a) Disrupt the illicit drug traffic in the Kentucky area by immobilizing targeted violators and trafficking organizations.
- b) Gather and report intelligence data relating to trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs.
- c) Conduct undercover operations where appropriate and engage in other traditional methods of investigation in order that the Task Force's activities will result in effective prosecution before the courts of the United States and the State of Kentucky.
