A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE A CONDITIONAL COMMITMENT LETTER AND AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT AN AWARD OF \$3,725,000 IN FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE KENTUCKY CLEANER WATER ROUND 2 GRANT (AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS). FOR

CLEANER WATER ROUND 2 GRANT (AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS), FOR THE TOWN BRANCH WWTP DEWATERING PUMP STATION REHABILITATION PROJECT, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT

BUDGET.

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute a conditional commitment

letter and an agreement with the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority, which are attached

hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to accept \$3,725,000 in federal funds under

the Kentucky Cleaner Water Round 2 Grant (American Rescue Plan Act funds), for the

Town Branch WWTP Dewatering Pump Station Rehabilitation project, the acceptance of

which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Section 7-48 of the Lexington-Fayette

Urban County Government Code of Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her

discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the

unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another

operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for

this Grant.

Section 3 -- That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
