SUBJECT: Request Council authorization to approve renewal of agreement with OmniSource Integrated Supply, LLC, for provision of temporary employees to perform inventory specialist activities for the Division of Emergency Management/911 under the Metropolitan Medical Response System--2012 grant in the amount of \$30,000.

In response to RFP 14-2010, OmniSource Integrated Supply, LLC was selected to provide temporary employees to perform inventory specialist activities for the Division of Emergency Management/911. The posted RFP provided for a one-year contract with four one-year renewals. Initial contract was approved by Council on July 6, 2010 (Resolution No. 410-2010).

The Division of Emergency Management/911 has requested a one-year renewal in the amount of \$30,000 for these services. Funds are budgeted as follows:
