SUBJECT: Kiddie Kapers Annual Spring Recital at the Opera House

Request:

This is a request for Council to enter into a license of Agreement with the Lexington Center Corporation for Lexington Parks & Recreation to hold its annual Kiddie Kapers Spring Recital at the Lexington Opera House.

Purpose:

Lexington Parks & Recreation has held their end of year program recital for Kiddie Kapers dance since 1999. The recital is the culmination of 22 weeks of classes from September through April with up to 800 students performing.

Budgetary Implication:

No budgetary impact.

Lexington Parks & Recreation receives a subsidy from the Opera House fund covering 50% of the bill. Ticket revenue is collected by the Opera House's ticket system Ticket Master and covers the balance of the rental costs. Remaining ticket revenue is paid out to Parks.
