**SUBJECT: Grant Award from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services**

**Request:**

Council Authorization to accept award of state funding in the amount of \$10,000 from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services for the Division Fire and Emergency Services for Fiscal Year 2020.

**Why are you requesting?**

On January 31, 2019 (Resolution 27-2019), the Division of Fire and Emergency Services received approval to submit a grant application requesting funding from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services (KBEMS) in the amount of \$10,000 for Fiscal Year 2020. This funding has now been awarded by KBEMS. Funds will be used for the purchase of Mass Casualty Equipment for the training of EMT and Paramedic personnel within the division. This equipment will be used to teach continuing education to all firefighters in mass casualty procedures.

These are state funds pursuant to KRS 311A.155. No matching funds are required.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?**

\$10,000 in state funds has been awarded for Fiscal Year 2020. There are no anticipated costs in future years.
