RE: Collective Bargaining Agreement – Corrections Officers and Sergeants

Request:

The Department of Law, on behalf of the Divisions of Community Corrections and Human Resources, requests a Resolution accepting the Collective Bargaining Agreement between LFUCG and Fraternal Order of Police, Town Branch Lodge #83, Community Corrections Officers and Sergeants, and authorizing the Mayor to execute the same. A red-line copy of the agreement, which has been ratified by the Lodge, is attached. A final version of the bargaining agreement will be provided for the formal signing.

Why are you requesting?

This action is requested because the Council previously adopted Resolution No. 329-2011 (attached), which requires negotiated collective bargaining agreements to be placed before the Council for acceptance. Pursuant to the resolution, the summary statement regarding the impact of the agreement is also attached.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

This agreement, which is 4 years in length, expiring June 30, 2030, is anticipated to cost an estimated **additional** amount of approximately \$6.8 Million for its term. All of the costs for FY 2026 are fully budgeted.

Are the funds budgeted?

All funds are budgeted for FY 26.
