AGREEMENT

Agreement between The University of North Florida Training and Service Institute, Inc., d/b/a the Institute of Police Technology and Management, Jacksonville, Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, Lexington, Kentucky,

FOR

Providing professional, technical and other services needed in conducting a twenty-four (24) hour training course entitled "Burglary Investigations" for a maximum of forty (40) students.

It is agreed that the Institute of Police Technology and Management will provide the following at Lexington:

- One instructional program in "Burglary Investigations"
- 2. To commence on January 14, 2013 and conclude on January 16, 2013.
- 3. Instructional materials prepared at the Institute of Police Technology and Management.
- 4. Trainee materials prepared for dissemination during the course.
- 5. An appropriate Certificate of Completion for each trainee satisfactorily completing the course.
- 6. Technical assistance required to prepare, conduct and evaluate the course.
- 7. Training aids and student reference materials.
- 8. Making all arrangements for obtaining instructors, preparation of the instructor activities and all other arrangements pertaining to instructor transportation and honoraria.

The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government agrees to pay a total sum of eleven thousand five hundred dollars (\$11,500) to the Institute of Police Technology and Management for conducting this course for a maximum of forty (40) students. Course may be cancelled 30 days prior to start date with no penalty. A 10% cancellation fee will be charged any time thereafter.
