Agreement for Use of Horse's Name and Silk Design in Public Installation

This Agreement made the 11 day of November, 2021 by and between the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, on behalf of the Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works, Division of Engineering, located at 101 E. Vine Street, Lexington, KY 40507 (hereinafter "LFUCG"), and

The Museum of the Southwest, Midland, Texas ("Museum"), having rights to the silk design of **Alysheba**, a thoroughbred horse, (hereinafter "Museum") (collectively the "Parties").

WHEREAS, LFUCG has an interest in using the horse name and silk design for the following public displays: the horse's name displayed on a stone wall set within the right-of-way at one of the four pedestrian corners at the intersection of Versailles Road and Alexandria Drive, covering an area of approximately 700 square feet; and the horse's silk design displayed on a banner mounted in the Versailles Road median between Village Drive and Mason Headley Road, (hereinafter the "Public Installation").

WHEREAS, Museum does not object to the use by LFUCG of the horse's name and silk design for the Public Installation until such Public Installation is removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration and under the conditions set forth above, the parties hereto agree to the following terms and conditions:


