**SUBJECT: 2025 Crumb Rubber/Tire-Derived Products Grant Application for the  
Family Care Center**

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**Request:** Council authorization to submit a grant application for \$8,065 in state funding, and to accept an award if offered, to the Commonwealth of Kentucky Waste Tire Program, the acceptance of which obligates the government to provide match in the amount of \$2,016.25.

**Purpose of Request:** A grant application has been prepared by the Department of Social Services for submission to the Commonwealth of Kentucky requesting state funds in the amount of \$8,065 from the Crumb Rubber/Tire-Derived products Grant for Waste Tire Market Development 2025 Application. The Family Care Center Courtyard existing furniture is aged and in need of replacement. If awarded, this grant would furnish the courtyard with benches and picnic tables using Kentucky recycled tire derivatives.

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?** It is anticipated that state funds in the amount of \$8,065 will be available for operations in FY2025 and FY2026. The minimum local match required for the operation of the project is 25% match of \$2,016.25. Funds for grant match contingency for new applications would be sufficient to cover the required match with no additional General Fund impact.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget amendment will be completed if approved.
