SUBJECT: First Amendment to Agreement with Lexington-Fayette Urban County Housing

Authority for Landlord Engagement

Request: Council authorization to execute Amendment to an Agreement with Lexington-Fayette Urban County Housing Authority to extend the period of performance for operation of a Landlord Engagement and Recruitment Program through June 30, 2026, at no additional cost.

Purpose of Request: In June 2024, Lexington-Fayette Urban County Housing Authority was awarded funding for the purposes of operating a landlord engagement and recruitment program. The purpose of this program was to encourage landlord participation in housing assistance programs serving those experiencing homelessness. This program was intended to address increased challenges in identification of affordable housing units to be paired with vouchers and other forms of rental assistance.

Staffing challenges led to significant funds remaining on this award. As such, the Office of Homelessness Prevention and Intervention seeks to extend the period of performance through June 30, 2026 at no additional cost. Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government has also revised the budget and target outcomes based upon knowledge gained during program operations, reflecting activities most successful in attracting and retaining partner landlords.
