**SUBJECT: Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for
Fourth Street Corridor Enhancement Project**

Request: Council authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, accepting additional federal funds in the amount of \$8,800 for the Fourth Street Corridor Enhancement Project for additional design costs.

Purpose of the Request: On June 23, 2016 (Resolution 394-2016), Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$130,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program for streetscape improvements to the Fourth Street Corridor. Streetscape, vehicular and pedestrian improvements to the 4th Street Right of Way corridor between Jefferson Street and Upper Street will include: curb and gutter, sidewalks, asphalt pavement surfacing, sustainable green infrastructure drainage improvements, signage improvements, new street and pedestrian level lighting for improved and safer pedestrian movement, and intersection traffic calming at 4th and Jefferson, 4th and Broadway, and 4th and Upper Street.

KYTC has offered an additional \$8,800 for additional design costs.

The Cost in this budget Year and future budget years: Total additional federal funding in this budget year is \$8,800. Matching funds in the amount of \$2,200 are required. Total project cost is \$11,000. Match will come from Transylvania University. No additional costs are anticipated.
