Request Council authorization to accept the Participating Addendum NASPO Value Point agreement with Ceragon Networks Inc. to establish a price contract for needed radio equipment for the Division of Enhanced 911 and authorizing the Mayor to sign this agreement.

Why are you requesting?

Lexington's backbone of the P25 radio system communications makes use of Ceragon microwave equipment. The plan is to replace aging equipment this fall and having the PA will save a great deal of money on the products of choice. The option of reliable equipment at 58% savings provides needed options.
