SUBJECT:

Agreement between LFUCG and Norfolk Southern Railroad for installation of Sanitary Sewer Line

to eliminate the Spurr Road and Dotson Pump Stations

Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement between Norfolk Southern Railroad and LFUCG to install a sanitary sewer line to eliminate 2 sanitary sewer pump stations located between 2710 Sullivans Trace and 2811 Spurr Road. The agreement is renewable in 20 years with a cost not to exceed \$23,215.00.

Purpose of Request

The requested resolution will authorize acceptance of the agreement between LFUCG and Norfolk Southern Railroad permit #1310998 to install sanitary sewer utilities under a Norfolk Southern owned railroad track.

Agreement Cost in FY24

The cost to execute the agreement is \$23,215.00.
