## Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

- Authorization to approve a change order to agreement with EC 0413-14 а Matthews, Co., Inc. for replacement of the arch entryway at the Division of Community Corrections. (L0413-14) (Ballard/Mason) This is a request to approve a change order to agreement with EC Co., Inc. for an amount of \$19,420 Matthews. for replacement of the arch entryway at the Division of Community Corrections. This increase brings the new total cost of the project to \$97,725. Funds are budgeted.
- 0414-14 Authorization to execute agreement with Siemens Industry, Inc., b a sole source provider, for annual maintenance of the fire alarm the Division of Community (L0414-14) at Corrections. (Ballard/Mason) This is a request to execute agreement with Siemens Industry, Inc., a sole source provider, for annual maintenance of the fire alarm at the Division of Community Corrections for a term of five (5) years beginning March 15, 2014. The cost for the first year is \$24,635. Funds are budgeted.
- c 0433-14 Authorization to execute Amendment No. 1 to Lease Agreement with Alfalfa Restaurant, LCC, for annual rent increase for space within the Downtown Arts Center. (L0433-14) (Reed) This is a request to execute Amendment No. 1 to Lease Agreement with Alfalfa Restaurant, LCC, to specify that all future payments for natural gas utility service to the restaurant shall be paid by the Tenant. Payments shall commence on July 1, 2014 and in exchange, the annual rental increases as specified in the Agreement shall be suspended for the next three fiscal years (2015, 2016, & 2017). Should the Tenant continue occupying the space beyond June 30, 2017, Tenant shall continue paying for their natural gas usage and annual rent increases shall again be applied.
- d 0434-14 Authorization to submit application, and accept award if offered, to Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for funding under the Law Enforcement Protection Program for purchase of soft body armor vests. - 0437-14 f Authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet additional the accepting federal funds for utility phase of bike lane project on Rose Street. (L0437-14) (Gooding/Paulsen) This is a request to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet accepting additional federal funds in the amount of \$25,000 for utility phase of bike lane project on Rose Street. This increase brings the new total project cost to \$57,250. A local match of \$6,250 is required. Budget amendments are in process.
- **g** 0440-14 Authorization to execute agreement with Kentucky American Water Company for relocation of utilities on Rose Street between Euclid Avenue and Rose Lane for the Rose Street Bike Lane Project. Budget amendments are in process.
- h 0443-14 Authorization to amend Resolution #16-2013 to increase the funding amount for a supplemental environmental project at the Police Canine Facility. - i 0449-14 Authorization to accept dedication of the private road located north of the Richmond Road Home Depot store in perpetuity to Public Use. (L0449-14) (Reed) This is a request to accept dedication of the private road located

north of the Richmond Road Home Depot store in perpetuity to Public Use. The section of road starts at the west end of the Woodhill Drive extension and ends at the Southland Christian Church property line. This road has been used by the general public for more than five consecutive years and will provide access to the new senior citizen's center. There is no immediate financial impact, however the city will assume responsibility for repair and maintenance.

- j 0452-14 Authorization to execute an amended agreement with EOP Architects to include design services for Phase B, C and D of the Replacement Senior Citizen Center. (L0452-14) (Reed) This is a request to execute an amended agreement with EOP Architects to include an additional amount of \$604,555 for design services for Phase B, C and D of the Replacement Senior Citizen Center. This amount plus \$158,965 for Phase A brings the new total cost to \$763,520. Funds are budgeted.

This increase brings the new total cost to \$56,086.54. Funds are budgeted.
