Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

Authorization to Amend Resolution 10-2016, which authorized a change order to the contract with Alpha Mechanical Services, inc., to correct the adjusted price of the contract. Resolution 10-2016, as passed, states that the change order is increasing the contract price from \$869,627.00 to \$879,267.00 while the change order is actually increasing the contract price from \$69,627.00 to \$79,267.00 Funds are budgeted.
