A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE

KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT AN AWARD OF \$11,868,095.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE KENTUCKY CLEANER WATER

GRANT (AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS), FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CHEMICAL DISINFECTION EQUIPMENT AT TOWN BRANCH AND WEST HICKMAN

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANTS, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN

THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the

Kentucky Infrastructure Authority, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by

reference, to accept \$11,868,095.00 in federal funds under the Kentucky Cleaner Water

Grant (American Rescue Plan Act funds), for the replacement of chemical disinfection

equipment at the Town Branch and West Hickman Wastewater Treatment Plants, the

acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government to the expenditure of

funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget

previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 -- That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
