1.04 BID SCHEDULE

The Bidder agrees to perform all the Work described in the Specifications and shown on the Plans for the following proposed lump sum and/or unit prices, if applicable, which shall include the furnishing of all labor, materials, supplies, equipment and/or vehicle usage, services, all items of cost, overhead, taxes (federal, state, local), and profit for the Contractor and any Subcontractor involved, within the time set forth herein. If unit prices are applicable, Bidder must make the extensions and additions showing the total amount of Bid. In all cases of discrepancies or math errors the amount written in for the unit price of an item shall govern.

If a discrepancy between the unit price and the item total exists, the unit price prevails except:

If the unit price and the item total are illegible or are omitted, the bid may be determined nonresponsive. If a lump sum total price is illegible or is omitted, the bid may be determined nonresponsive.

By submitting a Bid, the Bidder acknowledges that the trenchless constructability of all tunnels shown on the Contract Drawings have been vetted by the Bidder and that the Bidder's own design has been advanced to the extent necessary to establish, in the Bidder's own opinion, the ability to safely construct by means of tunneling methods.

A Preliminary Tunnel Plan shall be developed by the Bidder, concurrent with the development of the Bid, to document the Bidder's awareness and understanding of the quantity of, location of, and access to the portions of the Contract that are required to be built by trenchless means. The Preliminary Tunnel Plan is a conceptual plan establishing the capability to accomplish the tunnel construction required by Contract. Following award of the Contract, the Contractor shall modify the Preliminary Tunnel Plan as needed to develop the most efficient construction plan of operation in accordance with Contract Documents. Requirements for submittal of and content of the Preliminary Tunnel Plan shall be in accordance with this Section.

Apparent Low Bidder shall submit, no later than 48 hours after Bid Opening, a Preliminary Tunnel Work Plan as part of its Bid. The Preliminary Tunnel Work Plan shall consist of sketches, markups, and/or narrative explanations. Legible handwritten notes on Bid Documents (e.g.: Bid Drawings) are acceptable. The Preliminary Tunnel Work Plan shall include the following:

- A. Indication of diameter, type, and material of initial tunnel support, casings, or jacking pipe for each tunnel.
- B. Indication of tunnel drive direction.
- C. Indication of basic tunnel equipment type, size, make, and model anticipated such as tunnel boring machine size, microtunnel boring machine, pipe jacked shield, auger boring machine, or utility hand tunneling methods.
- D. Indication of conceptual understanding of all shaft locations, size (e.g.: diameter, length and width), orientation, anticipated conceptual method of support, staging/storage, and means of site access for each tunnel shaft as required for the Bidder's specific means and methods.
- E. Conceptual markup of plan, profile, or detail drawings of the following:
 - 1. groundwater removal process and safe discharge locations.
 - 2. spoil handling and storage,
 - 3. method of installation and blocking of carrier pipe, and

- 4. annular space grouting.
- F. Preliminary indication of all areas where potential ground modification strategies are anticipated or will be further explored by the Bidder upon award of the Contract.

For a unit price-based bid, the sum of the item totals is the bid amount the Owner uses for bid comparison.

The Owner's decision on the bid amount is final.



2.	During the abandonment of the existing forcemain how many lineal feet will be required to be drained in order to do the safe loading in the streets.	This work has been removed from the project scope and the submitted question is no longer applicable.
3.	Your specification lists Xypex C-1000 Red in Section 02608, 2.01, C. However, your specification calls for an anti-microbial additive in Section 02608, 2.01, D. Xypex Bio-San C500 contains waterproofing chemicals and anti-microbial components in a single package. It does not affect the air entrainment which has been reported to us from those using the ConShield product. It also has a brownish tint to it which will help with field identification. Will you approve Xypex C500 Bio-San for manholes covered under Section 02608, 2.01, D? Attached is performance data and product data for your review.	The Spec has been modified to provide the one manhole on the project with the Bio-San C500 in place of the original specified admixtures.





4.	Please advise the material of construction preferred for the combination air/vacuum valves? Section 02531, Part 2.06 mentions epoxy coated steel and reinforced nylon, but also calls out stainless steel as an option. The 3" valves are available with all three options, while the 4" valves are available in epoxy coated steel or stainless steel.	LFUCG's preference is for reinforced nylon in the 3" size and stainless steel in the 4" size. See changes to spec section 02531 below.

High velocity air will not shut the valve.

Valve designs that do not intentionally allow for intermittent release of air during operation shall not be considered equal or acceptable.
- L. The body and lower flange shall be constructed of reinforced nylon (3" size) or stainless steel (4" size).
- M. The drainage cover shall be constructed of 316 stainless steel (2" and 3") or PVC (4") or polyethylene (6" & 8").
- N. The float shall be constructed of 316 stainless steel or polypropylene as indicated on the drawings or in this specification and shall have a minimum clearance of 1" from each side wall to prevent blockage of the float.
- O. All metal hardware shall be 316 stainless steel. The sealing disc shall be E.P.D.M. All O-rings shall be of BUNA-N with pressure ratings equivalent to the overall working pressure of the valve.

 - B. All FRP pipe shall be tested after completion of the installation (including all restrained joints) at 150 psi or 250% of working design pressure, whichever is greater, not to exceed 1.5 x PN. Prior to testing, assure that all work has been properly completed. When filling the line assure that all air is expelled to avoid dangerous build-up of compressed air potential energy. Pressurize the line slowly, so pressure surges exceeding test pressures are not developed. Check for leaks when the test pressure has stabilized.

The collar shall have a radius 6-inches larger than the exterior wall of the base section. Contractor shall submit buoyancy calculations for all manholes within the 100-year floodplain to determine the actual width of the anti-floatation collar. Contractor shall assume buoyance of the manhole to an elevation equal to the 100-year flood elevation. Buoyance calculations shall have a factor of safety of 2.
- E. For concrete manholes, the inverts of the developed bases shall conform accurately to the size of the adjoining pipes. Side inverts shall be curved and main inverts (where direction changes) shall be laid out in smooth curves of the longest possible radius which is tangent, within the manhole, to the centerlines of adjoining pipelines.
- F. For concrete manholes, the cast iron frames and covers shall be the standard frame and cover as indicated on the LFUCG Standard Drawings.
- G. Manholes shall be manufactured by Sherman Dixie, Oldcastle Precast or approved equal.


