RE:

Roadway Transfers from Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) to Lexington-Fayette

Urban County Government (LFUCG)

Requesting authorization for LFUCG to take over ownership and maintenance of a number of roadways, as described in the attached request from KYTC, and further illustrated by the attached maps. Said roadways are currently maintained by KYTC. The Divisions of Engineering and Streets and Roads have made recommendations regarding assumptions of these roads for maintenance prior to the transfer to LFUCG and upon completion of these tasks as set forth in the attachment, LFUCG agrees to accept the maintenance and ownership of the roadways as described.

In order to formalize this request with KYTC, it is requested that Council pass a resolution to assume ownership and maintenance responsibility of the roadways. After receiving written authorization from LFUCG, KYTC will initiate an Official Order to transfer the subject roadways to LFUCG.
