A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE

KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET TO ACCEPT A GRANT OF \$355,656.01 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET

TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) (\$43,656.01) AND THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET SURFACE TRANSPORTATION

PROGRAM (SLX) (\$312,000.00), FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE ROSEMONT GARDEN SIDEWALK PROJECT, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH

OBLIGATES THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO THE EXPENDITURE OF \$88,914.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER

UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute an Agreement, which

is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the Kentucky

Transportation Cabinet to accept a Grant of \$355,656.01 in federal funds from the

Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)

(\$43,656.01) and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Surface Transportation Program

(SLX) (\$312,000.00), for the construction phase of the Rosemont Garden Sidewalk

Project, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government to the expenditure of \$88,914.00 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 97-21, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant

budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
