- 4. The Unit cost shown above is used a reasonable cost indicator and is not a representation of the actual unit cost for each debris type.
- 5. The Thoroughbred Disposal Landfill and the Haley Pike Waste Management Facility share a Kentucky Division of Waste Management permit. These facilities are adjacent to each other. However, approximately 6,011.5 CY of tree stumps and branches were taken to the latter. For location information see attachment:
