SERVICES TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Emerson Network Power Liebert Services, Inc. (fixia Liebert Global Services, Inc.) is herein referred to as the "Seller" and the customer or entity purchasing services ("Services") and parts required for Services ("Parts") from Seller is referred to as the "Buyer". These Services Terms and Conditions, any price list or schedule, quotation, acknowledgment, Seller's scope of work, or invoke from Seller relevant to the provision of Services and all documents incorporated by specific reference herein or therein, constitute the complete and exclusive statement of the terms of this agreement ("Agreement") governing the salle of Services and Parts by Seller to Buyer. Any discrepancies between the terms of the story reference therein or Buyer's procedures that the research of positions or order is expressly conditional on Buyer's assent to all of the terms of this Agreement, including terms and conditions that are different from or additional to the terms and conditions of Buyer's purchase order.

- 1. PRICES: Unless otherwise specified in writing by Seller, the price quoted or specified by Seller for the Services shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days after the date of Seller's quotation, Seller's scope of work or acknowledgment of Buyer's order for the Services, whichever occurs first, provided an unconditional authorization from Buyer for the performance of the Services is received and accepted by Seller within such time period. If authorization is not received by Seller within such thirty (30) day period, Seller's shall have the right to change the price for the Services. All prices are exclusive of taxes, which are to be borne by Buyer. Unless otherwise specified by Seller, Parts will be furnished at Seller's then required in critical.
- 2. IAXES: Any current or future tax or governmental charge (or increase in same) affecting Seller's costs of Services or costs of production, sale, delivery or shipment of Parts, or which Seller is otherwise required to pay or collect in commention with the provision of Services and Parts, shall be for Buyer's account and shall be added to the price or belied to Buyer separately, at Seler's election.
- 3. TERMS OF PAYMENT: Unless otherwise specified by Seler, terms of payment are net 30 days from date of Seller's invoice. Seller shall have the right, among other remedies, either to terminate this Agreement or to suspend further performance under this Agreement ander other agreements with Buyer in the event Buyer fails to make any payment when due, which other agreements Buyer and Seler hereby amend accordingly. Buyer shall be failed for all expenses, including atterneys' fees, relating to the coelection of past due amounts. If any apparent owed to Seler is not paid when due, it shall bear interest, at a rate to be determined by Seler, which shall not exceed the maximum rate permitted by they, from the date on which it is due untal it is paid. Seler may preserve its interests in payment by referring any applicable mechanics, construction or similar feer rights. Should Buyer's financial responsibility become unsatisfactory to Seler, cash payments or security satisfactory to Seler may be required by Seler for future performance of Services or provision of Parts. If such cash payment or security particularly to Seler the rights and remedies, Seler may discordince performance of Services and provision of Parts. All purchases paid by credit card shall be charged a 2.0% usage surcharge of the invoice total, for fees paid by Seller to accept credit card transactions.
- 4. SHPMENT AND DELIVERY. While Seller will use all reasonable commercial efforts to maintain the performance dates acknowledged or quoted by Seller, all performance dates are approximate and not guaranteed. Seller, at it is option, shall not be bound to tender delivery of any Parts for which Buyer has not provided shipping instructions and other required information. If the provision of Services or shipment of the Parts is postponed or delayed by Buyer for any reason, Buyer agrees to reimburuse Seler for any and all storage costs and other additional expenses resulting thereform. Unless otherwise specified by Seller, for salles of Parts in which the end destination of the Parts as obtained. States, risk of loss and legal title to the Parts shall transfer to Buyer immediately after the Parts have passed beyond the termiorial limits of United States. For all other shipments, risk of loss and legal title shall pass from Seller for Buyer upon delivery to and receipt by carrier at Seller's shipping point. Notwithstanding the above, risk of loss and legal title to Parts shall transfer to Buyer (i) when delivered by the individual providing the Services, or (ii) at the time Parts are placed in storage due to Buyer's delay or pestoponement. Any claims for shortages or damages surfeced in transf are the responsibility of Buyer and shall be submitted by Buyer directly to the carrier. Shortages or damages must be identified and signed for at the time of delivery.
- 5. LIMITED WARRANTY: Subject to the limitations of Section 6, Seller warrants that it will perform the Services as described in this Agreement and will exercise all reasonables skill, care and due diligence in the performance of the Services and shall perform the Services in accordance with professional practice. Seller warrants that all Services performed shall be free from faulty workmanship for a period of third good gave from completion of Services. To the extend assignable, Seler assignable Buyer any warrantes that are made by manufacturers and suppliers of Parts. EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED ABOVE, PARTS FURNISHED HEREUNDER ARE FURNISHED AS-IG, WHERE-IS, WITH NO WARRANTYE WHATSOEVER. THE WARRANTIES HERS SET ORSTHIN THIS SECTION SARE THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE WARRANTIES HER BY SELLER WITH RESPECT TO THE SERVICES AND PARTS AND ARE IN LIEU OF AND EXCLUDE ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS IN MITHER AND ALIGNMENT OF THE WARRANTIES FOR THE SERVICES AND THE SER

This warranty does not extend to any losses or damages due to misuse, accident, abuse, neglect, normal wear and tear, negligence (other than Sellet's), unsubhrized modification or alteration, use beyond rated capacity, unsuitable power sources or environmental conditions, improper installation, repair, handling, maintenance or application or any other cause not the fault of Sellet. To the extent that Buyer or its agents have suspiced specifications, information, representation of operating conditions or other data to Sellet that is used in (i) the selection of the Services and/or Parts and (i) the preparation of Sellier's quotation and/or scope of work, and in the event that actual operating conditions or other conditions differ from those represented by Buyer, any warranties or other provisions contained herein that are affected by such conditions shall be null and void.

Buyer assumes all other responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to persons or property arising out of, connected with, or resulting from the use of Services or Parts, either alone or in combination with other parts.

6. <u>LIMITATION OF REMEDY AND LIABILITY</u>. THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR BREACH OF ANY WARRANTY HEREUNDER SHALL BE LIMITED TO, AT SELLER'S SOLE OPTION, ETHER CORRECT PERFORMANCE FOR THAT PORTION OF THE SERVICES FOUND BY SELLER TO BE DEFECTIVE OR REFUND OF THE PRICE PAIR FOR SERVICES.

SELLER SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY DELAY IN PERFORMANCE AND THE REMEDIES OF BUYER SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT ARE EXCLUSIVE. INSURANCE: Seller shall maintain the following insurance or self-insurance coverage: Worker's Compensation in accordance with the statutory requirements of the state in which the work is performed. Employer's Liability with a limit of liability of \$2,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury by accident or bodily injury by disease. Commercial General Liability (CGL) for bodily injury and properly damage with a limit of \$2,000,000 per occurrence and aggregate. CGL includes Contractual Liability, CGL does not include Products and Competed Operations coverage, which is self-insured. Authornoble Liability insurance that covers usage of all owned, non-owned and leased vehicles and which is subject to a combined single limit per occurrence of \$2,000,000. Buyer expressly acknowledges and agrees that Seller has set its prices and entered into this Agreement in reliance upon the limitations of liability, insurance coverage, and other terms and conditions specified herein, which allocate the risk between Seller and Buyer and form a basis of this bargain between the parties.

8. EXCUSE OF PERFORMANCE: Seler shall not be liable for delays in performance or for non-performance due to acts of God, war; epidemic, fire: flood, weather; sabotage; strikes or labor disputes; civil disturbances or riots; governmental requests, restrictions, allocations, laws, regulations, orders or actions; unavailability of delays in transportation, default of supplies; or unforessent circumstances; activations or orassons of Buyer, notuding, without limitation, those specified in Section 19, or any events or causes beyond Seler's reasonable control. Buyer shall have ten (10) days from the date of completion of each portion of the Services to inspect the Services, and in the event of any non-conformity, Buyer must give written notice to Seller within said period stating why the Services are not conforming. Failure by Buyer to give such notice constitutes unqualified acceptance of the Services.
- 14. BILLABLE SERVICES: Additional charges will be billed to Buyer at Seller's then prevailing labor rates for any of the following: a) any Services not specified in Seller's order admonwhedgement, Seller's scope of work, or other documents referenced herein and therein, b) any Services performed at times other than Seller's normal service hours; of filmsly and reasonable sits and/or equipment access denied the Seller service representative; of it is in secssary, due to local cincumstances, to use union labor or her an outside contractor. Seller Service personnel will provide supervision only and the cost of such union or contract labor will be charged to Buyer; oil **Elevice or regard necessary to return equipment to proper operating condition as a result of other than Seller (maintainsance, speak; or modification (including, without limitation, changes in specifications or incorporation of attachments or other features). (it missue on regilect, circluding, without limitation charges in specifications and included the seller of the seller operation of seller or persiste equipment in a reasonable manner), (it is failer to persiste equipment in coordance with applications, and (if it is comply with as obligations herein, or (it) any additional obligations or requirements, including but not limited to those related to insurance requirements, service delivery, building entry or technical training.
- 15 <u>DRAWINGS</u>: Seller's documentation, prints, and drawings ("Documents") (including without limitation, the underlying technology) furnished by Seller to Buyer in connection with this Agreement are the property of Seller and Seller retains all rights, including without limitation, exclusive rights of use, Icensing and sale. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Buyer may use the Documents in connection with the Services and Parts.
- 16. EXPORTIMPORT: Buyer agrees that all applicable import and export control laws, regulations, orders and requirements, including without limitation those of the United States, and the jurisdictions in which the Selfer and Buyer are established or from which Services and Parts may be supplied, will apply to their receipt and use. In no event shall Buyer use, bransfer, release, import, or export Parts in violation of such applicable laws, regulations, orders or requirements.
- 17. NON-SOLICITATION: Buyer shall not solicit, directly or indirectly, or employ any employee of Seller during the period any Services are being provided to Buyer and for a period of one (1) year after the last provision of Services.

The validity, performance, and all other matters relating to the interpretation and effect of this Agreement shall be governed by the law of the state of Chio without regard to its conflict of laws principles. Buyer and Selfer agree that the proper venue for all actions arising in connection herewith shall be only in the country of installinis, state of Ohio, and the parties agree to submit to such jurisdiction. No action, regardless of form, issing out of transcrip relations relating to this contract, may be brought by either party more than two (2) years after the cause of action has accrued. The U.N. Convention on Contracts for the international Select of Goods shall not apply to the Agreement.

- 19 ADDITIONAL SERVICE CONDITIONS: The Buyer shall furnish to Seller, at no cost, suitable working space, storage space, adequate heat; telephone, light, ventilation, regulated electric power and outlier for testing purposes. The facilities shall be within a reasonable distance from where the Services are to be provided. Delier and its representatives shall have full and free access to the equipment or order to provide the necessary Services. Buyer authorizes Seller to send a service technician or an authorized agent to access any site requested by Buyer to perform services, including services on different scopes of work and equipment as respeased by Buyer. Buyer shall provide the means to subtled and secure electric power to the equipment under provide safe working conditions.
