AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM AGREEMENT

- 1. That pursuant to Section 5, "Term of Memorandum" of the attached Memorandum of Agreement between the parties, the term of the agreement is hereby extended by mutual agreement of the parties to June 30, 2018.
 - 2. All other provisions of the agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
