SUBJECT: Resolution amending R-383-2016 to include additional fiber connections in the KY Wired Contract and encumber additional funds.

Request:

Authorization to: amend R-383-2016 and execute an MOU with the Commonwealth of Kentucky to encumber additional funds for additional fiber infrastructure in Lexington-Fayette County at a cost not to exceed \$270,000 and accept a conduit license credit from the Commonwealth in the amount of \$70,320.

Why are you requesting?

Department needs this action completed because: there is an opportunity to provide fiber for the city's needs which will include fire stations, police locations, traffic lights, etc. for the cost of the fiber itself. No construction costs will be incurred by the city. It is dark fiber that will have the capability to provide 1GB of services for the city's needs. This amendment will add additional dark fiber.
