SUBJECT: HOPWA Grant Extension

Request:

Council authorization to execute the Amendment to Extend Period of Performance under Performance Renewal Grant Agreement of the HOPWA (Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids) Grant Program and to approve execution of an amendment to subrecipient agreement with AVOL through January 31, 2018.

Purpose of Request:

On April 27, 2014 (Resolution No. 481-2014) the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council approved receipt of funds in the amount of \$1,398,704 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for operation of housing programs for persons with AIDS. This resolution also approved execution of a subrecipient agreement with AIDS Volunteers, Inc. (AVOL), for operation of these programs. The agreement with HUD and the subrecipient agreement with AVOL expire December 31, 2017. Additional time is needed to fully expend grant funding.

HUD has offered the LFUCG an amendment to the agreement through January 31, 2018.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? This is a no cost amendment.
