# SUBJECT: Grant applications for the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program

#### **Request:**

Council authorization to submit applications to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security requesting federal funding in the amount of \$194,200 for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services under the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program.

## **Purpose of Request:**

The Kentucky Office of Homeland Security is accepting applications from local governments requesting federal funding from the Fiscal Year 2019 Homeland Security Grant Program. This federally funded program, originating from the Department of Homeland Security, provides financial assistance to the states to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. The states have the responsibility for apportioning funding to local governments. All projects must be related to the Goals and Objectives of the State Homeland Security Strategy.

The **Division of Fire and Emergency Services** has prepared applications requesting funding for the following equipment:
