**SUBJECT:** Neighborhood Action Match Program Contracts - Fiscal Year 2019

**Request:** Council authorization to execute FY19 Neighborhood Action Match Program contracts with the following: Copperfield Neighborhood Association (\$4,916), Historic Woodward Heights Neighborhood Association (\$3,648), Joyland Neighborhood Association (\$2,664), Martin Luther King Neighborhood Association (\$10,000), and Walnut Ridge Homeowners Association (\$5,304).

## Why are you requesting?

Grants and Special Programs received 30 applications requesting funds under the Fiscal Year 2019 Neighborhood Action Match Program. The Neighborhood Action Match Program Review Board met and reviewed requests for funding. Those projects listed above have been recommended for funding. Additional awards are anticipated once funds are made available.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? The cost in this budget year is not to exceed \$26,532.
