WHEREAS, GOVERNMENT and SUBRECIPIENT entered into an Agreement dated October 17, 2018 ("Agreement"), in which the SUBRECIPIENT was allocated \$50,000 in federal Community Development Block Grant Program funds (CFDA # 14.218) as provided by the 2018 Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan for the purpose the operation of the SUBRECIPIENT'S Fair Housing Enforcement, Education and Outreach;

WHEREAS, GOVERNMENT requires a change to the Time of Performance;

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for all amendments to be in writing executed by GOVERNMENT and SUBRECIPIENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutually agreed upon promises, conditions, and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Article I, "STATEMENT OF WORK," section F, Schedule – Time of Performance, shall be amended to read as follows:

"The term of this Agreement shall be October 1, 2018, through December 31, 2020."

In all other respects, except as specifically modified herein, the terms of the Agreement dated October 17, 2018, shall remain in full force and effect with respect to the provisions outlined therein.
