SUBJECT: Travel Time Analytics Platform Agreement with INRIX, Inc.

Request: Council authorization to spend additional funds for data license agreement with INRIX, Inc. to provide online travel time analytics software platform, to monitor vehicular travel times on roadways in Fayette County and Jessamine County for year 2 for \$75,000 for FY2020 and subsequent years for \$75,000 FY2021 at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

Purpose of the Request: On June 20, 2019 (Resolution 307-2019), Council authorized the acceptance of federal funds for the ITS/CMS (Intelligent Transportation System/Congestion Management System) Traffic Improvements Project for FY 2020. In order to comply with federal ITS standards, the Lexington Area MPO is required to update the ITS architecture a minimum of every five years.

On November 15, 2018 (Resolution 692-2018) council authorized and executed the Data License Agreement with INRIX, Inc. for \$111,000. Years 2 and 3 of the agreement are for \$75,000 each year. Funds for both years are budgeted.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Total cost for this FY2020 is \$75,000 and subsequent year \$75,000 for FY2021.

Are the funds budgeted? Yes.
