A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AND TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THIS GRANT APPLICATION, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,500.00 FEDERAL FUNDS AND \$2,640.00 COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY FUNDS, UNDER THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM, AND ARE FOR THE PROCUREMENT AND INSTALLATION OF TWELVE (12) FLOOD WARNING MARKERS AND SIGNS IN FAYETTE COUNTY.
