A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,810.55 IN FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE 2019 FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE AND

PREVENTION AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SMOKE ALARMS FOR HOUSEHOLDS IN HIGH-RISK NEIGHBORHOODS, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF \$1,190.53 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS

WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept a Grant from the United

States Department of Homeland Security, which Grant funds are in the amount of

\$23,810.55 in Federal Funds, under the 2019 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Program,

for the purchase and installation of smoke alarms for households in high-risk

neighborhoods, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Government for the expenditure of \$1,190.53 as a local match.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget

established herein.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
