SUBJECT: Grant for Ticketing Aggressive Cars and Trucks

Request: Council authorization to execute a Memorandum of Agreement, accepting federal funds in the amount of \$20,000 from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Kentucky State Police for Ticketing Aggressive Cars and Trucks grant program – FY 2021. Match in the amount of \$4,413 is budgeted.

Why are you requesting?

The Kentucky State Police has received high priority Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program funds from the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration for continuation of the TACT ("Ticketing Aggressive Cars and Trucks") Grant Program in Kentucky. The Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet has offered the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Division of Police funds to conduct TACT activities.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Federal funding in the amount of \$20,000 will be provided by Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet to LFUCG for officer overtime in the performance of TACT activities. Match of \$4,413 is required and will come from existing budgeted staff salaries in the Division of Police. Total cost of the project is \$24,413. There is no anticipated cost for future budget years.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment 10851 is in process.
