**SUBJECT: Amendment to the agreement for Harrods Hill Recreation Center under the  
Neighborhood Action Match Program**

**Request:** Council Authorization to execute an amendment to the Harrods Hill Recreation Center Neighborhood Action Match agreement providing an extension to the project to May 31, 2021 at no additional cost due to coronavirus.

**Purpose of Request:** On December 4, 2018 (Resolution 723-2018), Council authorized the award of \$10,000 in Neighborhood Action Match Program funds to the Harrods Hill Recreation Center for tennis court improvements.

On March 23, 2020 (Resolution 172-2020), Council authorized an extension for this project due to change in match and because the organization was unable to complete the original project and needed additional time due to delays.

Harrods Hill Recreation Center requests an extension to May 31, 2021 due to the coronavirus and reports being unable to obtain a vendor to perform concrete work within the current contract performance period.
