RESOLUTION NO. 521 -2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000.00 FROM THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, UNDER THE FY 2019 CHEMICAL STOCKPILE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM (CSEPP), FOR THE PURCHASE OF A ZUMRO TENT AND DECON SYSTEM FOR THE SUPPORT OF CONTINUED EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS ACTIVITIES IN FAYETTE COUNTY, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept additional Federal funds in the amount of \$40,000.00 from the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management, under the FY 2019 Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP), for the purchase of a Zumro tent and decon system for the support of continued Emergency Preparedness activities in Fayette County, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
