

RESOLUTION NO. 614 - 2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT AN AWARD OF \$511,078.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE THROUGH ITS COMPREHENSIVE OPIOID, STIMULANT, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SITE-BASED PROGRAM, IN ORDER TO CREATE THE LEXINGTON OVERDOSE OUTREACH PROJECT-2 (LOOP-2) FOR FY 2021, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept an award of \$511,078.00 in Federal funds from the U.S. Department of Justice through its Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Abuse Site-based Program, in order to create the Lexington Overdose Outreach Project-2 (LOOP-2) for FY 2021, the acceptance of which does not obligate the Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in her discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget established for this Grant.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
