Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY21 (Class A Neighborhood) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Griffin Gate Community Association, Inc., in the amount of \$10,293.20.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to address issues of erosion which are causing bare areas and heavy runoff both toward the foundation of the clubhouse structure, as well as into the streets and nearby storm sewer. The project elements include improving the grading and soil composition, as well as, providing stormwater education through a "Think Tank Sundays" event specifically to address stormwater management in the community.
