

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this _____ day of, _____ 2020, by and between **LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT**, an urban county government pursuant to KRS Chapter 67A, and located at 200 East Main Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507 (hereinafter referred to as "LFUCG"), and **UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY RESEARCH FOUNDATION**, whose address is 109 Kinkead Hall, Lexington, Kentucky 40506 (hereinafter referred to as "UKRF").

WHEREAS, LFUCG and UKRF entered into an Agreement dated April 25, 2019 ("Agreement"), in which UKRF was allocated **\$198,638.00** in federal funds as a subrecipient of a grant awarded to LFUCG from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance (Award # 2018-AR-BX-K059), for the support of the Lexington Overdose Outreach Project (LOOP);

WHEREAS, LFUCG requires a change to the **COMPENSATION AND TERM** of that Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for all amendments to be in writing executed by LFUCG and UKRF;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and mutually agreed upon promises, conditions, and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Article 3, "COMPENSATION AND TERM," sections (a) and (b), shall be amended to read as follows:

"(a) LFUCG agrees to retain UKRF from March 2019 through September 30, 2021 with a final report to be provided within 60 days of the contract end date.

(b) LFUCG shall compensate UKRF for the proposed services in an amount which shall not exceed **one hundred and eight thousand six hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$108,639.00)**, as outlined in the grant budget (Exhibit "1"), which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference."

In all other respects, except as specifically modified herein, the terms of the Agreement dated April 25, 2019, shall remain in full force and effect with respect to the provisions outlined therein.
