Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY21 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Andover Neighborhood Association, Inc. (ANA), in the amount of \$158,701.13.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to help improve water quality in the East Hickman Watershed in the Andover Neighborhood. The project elements include replacement of the failing concrete spillway at the former hole #17 pond; bank stabilization and construction of a riparian buffer along the northern bank of the #17 pond; replacement of portions of the cart path with pervious concrete; a community stream cleanup event extending along East Hickman Creek from Todds Road to the pond just upstream of Jacobson Reservoir; and placement of permanent signage at the proposed bank stabilization area explaining the benefits of riparian buffers and the improved concrete spillway.

Project Cost in FY21 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2021 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$158,701.13.
