#### Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY21 (Class B Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for The Living Arts and Science Center, Inc., in the amount of \$30,500.00.

### Purpose of Request

The purpose of the project is to develop and present additional curriculum and disseminate educational content utilizing established programs and LASC's facility and grounds. Grant funds will support programs such as the Kentucky Wildlife and Water Outreach Program, an after-school ecology program for LTMS students, Wildlife and Water Summer Camps, Eco Workshops, field trip programs, Water is Life Day, and ongoing educational displays. LASC anticipates reaching over 40,000 students, teachers, and family members through their various programs, regular classes, and workshops throughout the year. They also anticipate reaching additional audiences through field trips and activities at LASC, on their website, through social media, and in handouts.

## Project Cost in FY21 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2021 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$30,500.00.
