The Law

It is expressly acknowledged that LFUCG shall never be required or obligated to consent to any request for assignment or subcontract; and further that such refusal to consent can be for any or no reason, fully within the sole discretion of LFUCG.
- 14. No Waiver: No failure or delay by LFUCG in exercising any right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder, nor any single or partial exercise thereof, nor the exercise of any other right, remedy, power or privilege shall operate as a waiver hereof or thereof. No failure or delay by LFUCG in exercising any right, remedy, power or privilege under or in respect of this bid proposal or bid contract shall affect the rights, remedies, powers or privileges of LFUCG hereunder or shall operate as a waiver thereof.
- 15. Authority to do Business: Each bidder must be authorized to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and must be in good standing and have full legal capacity to provide the goods or services specified in the bid proposal. Each bidder must have all necessary right and lawful authority to submit the bid response and enter into the bid contract for the full term hereof including any necessary corporate or other action authorizing the bidder to submit the bid response and enter into this bid contract. If requested, the bidder will provide LFUCG with a copy of a corporate resolution authorizing this action and/or a letter from an attorney confirming that the proposer is authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All bid responses must be signed by a duly authorized officer, agent or employee of the bidder.
- Governing Law: This bid request and bid contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. In the event of any proceedings regarding this matter, the bidder agrees that the venue shall be the Fayette County Circuit Court or the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky, Lexington Division and that the bidder expressly consents to personal jurisdiction and venue in such Court for the limited and sole purpose of proceedings relating to these matters or any rights or obligations arising thereunder.
- 17. Ability to Meet Obligations: Bidder affirmatively states that there are no actions, suits or proceedings of any kind pending against bidder or, to the knowledge of the bidder, threatened against the bidder before or by any court, governmental body or agency or other tribunal or authority which would, if adversely determined, have a materially adverse effect on the authority or ability of bidder to perform its obligations under this bid response or bid contract, or which question the legality, validity or enforceability hereof or thereof.
- 18. Bidder understands and agrees that its employees, agents, or subcontractors are not employees of LFUCG for any purpose whatsoever. Bidder is an independent contractor at all times related to the bid response or bid contract.

TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

Please be advised of the following clarifications to the above referenced bid:

- 1. Has this package gone to bid in years past?
- -Yes.
- 2. Is there a problem building that routinely floods? If so, how often?
- -No. For the most part main line blockages and rain events are random in nature and so are the backup locations. We can have heavy sporadic rain that causes a flooded house or constant steady stream of rain over the span of a couple of days that can cause a building backup. In certain areas of Lexington we do have some issues when we have heavy amounts of rain in a short period of time. In this case while it is in the same area it may not as be the same location/house that is experiencing a backup during a rain event. For a main line blockage it could be several houses on a line that are experiencing a backup.
- Is a vendor currently servicing "cleaning service for flooding?"
 No
- 4. Line item #13 "room fogger" price per room? Obviously room sizes are different the bigger the more product. This will be changed to a square foot cost in lonwave.
- 5. The lessor sum of all 15 line items will awarded to bidder?
- -Typically the lowest bidder meeting requirements or multiple awards can be issued. It will be evaluated overall and based upon what is in the best interest for the City of Lexington.



6. This generally is submitted to insurance why is LFUCG sending out to bid?

-For the most part Water Quality wants to provide some sort of immediate cleaning service due to the backup of our main line due to rain or a mainline blockage. We only cover certain things that are outlined in this contract. We advise homeowners/business owners to file claim for other items that are not covered such as a damages to appliances or any other expenses that they have occurred.
