RE: Agreement with the Transit Authority for use of 800 MHz Radio System.

Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting authorization for the Mayor to sign an agreement with the Transit Authority of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (a/k/a Lextran) that allows access to the portion of the 800 MHz Radio System owned by this government.

Why are you requesting?

The agreement permits Lextran to program its radios to use Lexington's radio system for a fee of \$131.13 per radio/per year with provisions for a 3% annual increase in years two (2) through (5) of the agreement. Thereafter, the agreement is renewable on an annual basis. The agreement requires that Lextran provide its own radios, licenses, repairs, and programming services for the radio equipment it uses and to comply with terms of use outlined in the agreement.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?

There is no cost to the government.
