SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2022 Transportation Cabinet Traffic Safety Impaired Driving

Program

Request: Council authorization to accept federal funds of \$20,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety Impaired Driving Program. No local match is required.

Purpose of Request: The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Division of Police has been offered a grant of \$20,000 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety for Impaired Driving services. This funding originates from the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The purpose of this program is to reduce fatalities on Kentucky roadways, minimize injuries to individuals and property, and to educate the public in ways to do this. Funds will be used to support the cost of officer overtime and training.

Cost in this Budget Year and future budget years: The cost in Fiscal Year 2022 is \$20,000. No matching funds are required. Funding for future budget years is contingent upon award of federal funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment 11305 is in process.
