SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2022 Transportation Cabinet Traffic Safety Program

Request: Council authorization to accept federal funds of \$97,070 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety for participation in the Traffic Safety Program for Fiscal Year 2022. No local match is required.

Purpose of Request: The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Division of Police has been offered a grant of \$97,070 from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's Office of Highway Safety for participation in the Traffic Safety Program. These federal funds originate from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Highway Safety Standards Branch. The Transportation Cabinet has offered the Division of Police additional federal funding of \$97,070 for this program, which funds police overtime to detect speeders and other traffic violators.

Cost in this Budget Year and future budget years: The cost in Fiscal Year 2022 is \$97,070. No matching funds are required. Funding for future budget years is contingent upon award of federal funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment 11304 is in process.
