3	<b>Private Waste Collection Enforcement Options</b> –Placed in committee by CM Lamb. This item has been in committee since May 2018 and never had a presentation. If there are no plans to take action on this, <b>request a motion to remove</b>
4	<b>Waste Management Fines</b> – I believe CM LeGris has agreed to take ownership of this item. As a new CM, she may need additional time to get familiar with the intent behind this item.
5	<b>Review of Current Tax District Change Policy</b> – This item belongs to CM Plomin and it was last presented in July 2018. If there are no objections, <b>request a motion to remove</b> . It can be brought back if there is a plan for action.
