RE: Affordable Housing Fund report

Attached is a report detailing the activities of the Affordable Housing Fund since its inception in 2014.

A few highlights:

- 1. \$18,636,292 has been invested in the preservation and new construction of 2,390 affordable housing units in Fayette County. These funds have leveraged over \$284 Million in other resources.
- The Affordable Housing Fund Board has allocated funds for 694 units for Lexington's elderly residents (62 and over), including 231 new units that have recently opened or are under construction.
- 3. Of the 2,390 units, 1,003 are permanent supportive housing units for special needs populations.
- 4. In the next 2 years over 700 new affordable housing units will be placed in service, with the possibility of another 200 that are currently under consideration for funding.
- 5. All of the outstanding Affordable Housing Fund loans are paying as agreed.
