SUBJECT: Sole Source Resolution – Rave Mobility Safety

## Request:

A resolution recognizing Rave Mobility Safety as the sole source provider of Smart911 services to the Division of Enhanced 911.

Why are you requesting?

E911 has an existing agreement with Rave Mobility Safety for Smart911 (a/k/a SmartPreparer), which is a self-registration portal used by the public to create a profile for the person or household. When a subscriber dials 911, the caller's profile appears to the 911 Operator. Household profiles contain critical information to E911 and other first responders such as the caller's emergency contacts, pre-existing medical conditions, mobility issues, household members, access codes, etc.

Rave is offering a \$3,600 reduction in annual cost from \$72,000 to \$68,400 annually commencing on January 1, 2022.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?
